

# YUPO PAPER

## A NEW EXPERIENCE WITH WATERCOLOUR

Materials you will need:

### **PAINTS**

Any watercolour paints you have, including a bright yellow, orange, phalo blue and red .

Windsor and Newton Windsor Blue and Scarlet Lake (red) work well on the yupo paper but don't rush out to buy these colours if you don't have them in your selection

### **BRUSHES**

Any watercolour brushes you have mops and flat taclon brushes if you have them. A liner brush is also useful.

### **OTHER ITEMS**

I will have a supply of Yupo paper that you can purchase on the day

Box of tissues not ones with Aloevera or anything impregnated into them

Backing board for your paper

Masking tape

Water containers

Hair dryer

Charcoal pencil or willow charcoal

Small foam roller about 5 to 10cms try Bunnings paint or craft section or the \$2 shop

Spray bottle on that can give a fairly fine spray if possible.

Pallet or white plastic plate

Tracing paper (I will also have that with me if you wish to purchase some)

4b pencil

Cotton buds
