

## Acrylic Kit – Basic List for Workshops

**Supports:**

**Canvas Board** 20cm x 30cm minimum (A4 approx)

**OR Acrylic Canvas paper:** A4 Minimum

**Plus:** Backing Board & masking tape (coated cardboard OK)

**Paints:**

**Acrylic Artist Quality – 6 colour primaries** Such as; (Atelier Interactive)

Arylamide Yellow Light, Cadmium Yellow Deep

Pyrrrole Red Permanent Alizarin

Ultramarine Blue, Prussian Blue

Yellow Ochre Burnt Sienna,

Ivory Black, Large Titanium White

Others: Transparent Yellow, Cerulean Blue Viridian, Phthalo Blue, Raw Umber, Burnt Umber, Quinacridone Violet.

You can add to this as you wish. Colours may be suggested in class or you may discover them for yourself.

**Brushes:**

Synthetics are good and will satisfy a full range of taste and budget

**5 flats** of varying size (it is good to paint with a larger brush than you think you need.)

**1 small round for detailed work**

**Medium**

**A basic medium for blending paints such as Clear Painting Medium (Atelier) or matte medium.** Each manufacturer has different mediums for different purposes.

Try them as you can afford. It is mediums that make acrylics so versatile.

**Palette:**

Glass is best but any non-porous flat surface e.g. white plate or platters

I find a disposable palette such as Aquabee ideal for classes

Small disposable bowls

**Miscellaneous:**

Drawing Materials; Pencils, 2B, 4B, 6B, (Progresso)

**Charcoal Pencil (Vine/Generals - Hard)**

Sketch book/drawing pad, A3

**Synthetic/Malleable rubber**

**2 x Water containers (ice cream container or small plastic bucket)**

**Fine Spray Water bottle**

**Masking tape**

craft knife

Scissors

**Hair Dryer**

**Rags, Paper towels**

**Small note book, pen**
