The 29th CASS "Art of Sydney Awards" exhibition was held at the Australian National Maritime Museum, Terrace Room, Darling Harbour from 24 - 27 January 2019.

11 Ku-Ring-Gai Artists exhibited 27 paintings and 3 artworks by KAS artists - Vikki Jackson, Jennifer O'Young and Madeleine Szymanski - were sold during the 2019 Art of Sydney Awards exhibition.

5 KAS artists either won Awards of were selected as Finalists by the Judge, KEN KNIGHT.



WINNER – Section 6: 'Jaguar Removals' Award \$300.00 for Miniature Painting 'Lost and Found' by Madeleine Szymanski – Ku-Ring-Gai Art Society

Judge's comments: "This is a beautiful, mystical and romantic painting showing sensitivity to mood, design and strong drawing skills. I love the ethereal quality of this exceptional painting. This is undoubtedly one of the best paintings in the show and makes one realise that great things can come in small packages!"
